## NEXT EDITION OF "SOLID GOLD" STARS THE 5TH DIMENSION!!!!

Still going strong in the Riviera's Versailles Theatre is the highly popular "Solid Gold" show. Making their debut with "Solid Gold" on Thursday, Sept. 27 will be The 5th Dimension. The Smothers Brothers will close an almost-three-month engagement at the Riviera on Wednesday, Sept. 26.

The Versailles Theatre now has two cocktail shows nightly at 8 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. The cost for the show is \$17.50 while youths 16 years of age and under can attend any show for just \$12.50. "Solid Gold" will be dark on Sundays.

Although its been more than 12 years since the 5th Dimension entered the musical world with "Up, Up, and Away," the group is still soaring

The group, with most of the original members intact, have released

over a dozen hit albums and received 14 gold records. Their classics include such hits as Aquarius/Let the Sunshine In, One Less Bell To Answer, The Worst That Could Happen, This Is Your Life, Wedding Bell Blues, Stoned Soul Picnic, and Go Where You Wanna Go.

They headline in Las Vegas and Atlantic City regularly and tour throughout the United States, Europe and the Orient. The 5th Dimension holds six Grammy awards.

## Musical Cabaret to Open LV Little Theater Season

The Las Vegas Little Theater opens its seventh season with "2 By 5," a musical cabaret by John Kander and Fred Ebb. The production opens 8 p.m. Sept. 27, with subsequent performances 8 p.m. Thursdays through Saturdays, through Oct. 20. There will be 3 p.m. matinees Sept. 30 and Oct. 14.

For the first time in five years, the Little Theater will be raising ticket prices. The new admission is \$6 for adults., \$5 for seniors, students, groups and members of the Allied Arts Council.

Conceived and originally directed by Seth Glassman, "2 By 5" features music by John Kander and lyrics by Fred Ebb. The production weaves music from their most famous efforts, including "Cabaret" and "Chicago" with the lesser-known songs from "70, Girls, 70" and "Flora the Red Menace."

The Little Theater production is directed by Tim Conroy and produced by Jack Bell.
