The funds, which will be administered by the Northern Nevada Job Training Program and the Southern Nevada Employment and Training Program, are available for individuals 55 years of age or older who meet low income criteria.

Both agencies have trained counselors who specialize in job development, placement, job search skill training, testing and assessment.

Experienced senior workers will be helped find jobs and seniors who need training in new fields will be helped.

Dr. King's Condition improved, 'guarded"

ATLANTA — The Rev. Martin Luther King, Sr. improved to "guarded but stable" condition Monday, a day after he entered a hospital with complications of heart disease.

King, 84, had been listed in critical condition, but his condition was upgraded Monday, said Crawford W. Long Memorial Hospital spokeswoman Jane Morrison. King remained in the intensive care unit.

King, father of slain civil rights leader Martin Luther King, Jr. is known affectionately as "Daddy King." He is a retired pastor of Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta.

Steve Klein, spokesman for King's daughter-in-law Coretta Scott King, said the family had visited the ailing patriarch in the hospital.

King was hospitalized in August 1982 for an irregular heart beat and a buildup of fluid in the lungs. At that time, his docor said his heart was not pumping blood out of the lungs properly.


