

Black History Museum To Be Built In Atlanta

ATLANTA — A \$17.7 million museum dedicated to black American history will be built in Atlanta's Martin Luther King, Jr. Historic District, organizers say.

The African American Panoramic Experience, or "APEX," will feature life-size exhibits ranging from an African village to a replica of the crowded Montgomery, Ala., bus where Rosa Parks refused to sit in the back, triggering the civil rights boycotts of the 1950s and '60s.

The museum will also include an art gallery, archives, theaters, a library, gift shop and restaurant, said Dan Moore, one of the museum's organizers.

"We as a people, more than anybody else I can think of, need a better grasp on our history and need more positive self-images," he said.

Moore said the permanent home of APEX

will be housed in a 97,000 sq. ft., split-level building on two parcels of land to be acquired in the federally designated historic district, where King and others launched the civil rights movement.
