democratic change. In
1960, the Nobel Com-

mittee honored another
great black South African
advocate of non-violent
change — Albert Luthuli,
a leader of the later
outlawed African National
Congress.

Luthuli, like Tutu, re-
jected violence as a re-
sponse to the inhumanity
and brutality of racism
and apartheid. Today
some of Chief Luthuli's
followers have

been driven by decades
of murder, repression
and harassment into
pursuing an armed
struggle. Yet that strug-
gle is likely to lead to a
desperate bloodbath

from which no winners,
black or white, will
emerge.

Bishop Tutu knows
this and therefore
strongly advocates
peaceful public protest,

independent black or-
ganization for self-
defense, and a strong
black-led and multi-
racial trade union move-
ment as vehicles for
pressuring the regime.
