Pointer Sisters Opening For Mac Davis At MGM

LAS VEGAS — One of the most multi-talented performers ever to appear in Las Vegas, Mac Davis, will be opening at the MGM Grand on Thursday, Nov. 8, and will continue there through Nov. 21.

Opening the bill for Mac, in an unusual combination, will be the Pointer Sisters. The combination will perform at two cocktail shows a night in the MGM's beautiful Celebrity Room.

The Pointer Sisters bring a level of excitement to any show that can easily wake up a Las Vegas visitor made weary by all that partying and gambling.

As with many other singers before them, the Pointer Sisters first learned to sing in their church choir, in Oakland, Calif., where both their mother and father were ministers. In addition to the church, their singing influences included rhythm and

blues, soul and even country.

The Pointers first broke into the music business in San Francisco in 1969, but began to develop their satorial "nostalgia" look in 1973. Suddenly they began to catch on and were booked on Helen Reddy's summer show.

Their first big single hit was "Yes I Can" and was followed by "Fire" and "He's So Shy." Their first "crossover" hit to appeal to both black and white audiences was "Slow Hand."
