

EOB TO ELECT NEW BOARD MEMBERS

Elections will be held next month to choose representatives of the poor to the Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County, according to James Tyree, EOB Executive Director.

Any person at least 18 years old may file as a candidate. Five members will be elected to serve 3-year terms. Members are not paid for their services which call for attending at least one Board Meeting each month. In addition to the

five people elected to represent the poor, elected public officials and private organizations make up the remainder of the 15-member Board.

Anyone interested in filing as a candidate for the Dec. elections must do so by Nov. 30. Filing forms are available at EOB Headquarters, 2228 Comstock.
