

Highway Contracts Earn Award For Minority Business

Governor Richard Bryan, Transportation Board Chairman, today announced the Transportation Department received an award for its small minority business opportunity program. It was recognized for its award of \$18.5 million in highway contracts to disadvantaged business enterprises during the 1984 federal fiscal year.

The State Transportation Board which includes Attorney General Brian McKay and Controller Darrel Daines directed emphasis be placed on increasing involvement of minorities and women in the highway contracting business.

The Department is the first state agency to be honored with this annual award. It was presented to NDOT Contract Compliance Officer Sal Quilici by Nevada Economic Development Company from Las Vegas and the U.S. Department of Commerce. NEDCO is a minority business development agency representing local and state government as well as minority businesses. Directly working with the Department is New Ventures, a minority supporting services contractor to NDOT.

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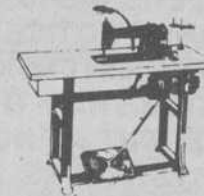
