tial resume of the accomplishments of the Hoggards which are too numerous to mention at this time:

Phi Delta Kappa Sorority believes in giving recognition to those deserving it while they are able to see and appreciate what is being done in their honor and they felt that this tribute to the Hoggards was long overdue for they have both made a tremendous impact on this community through their generous financial contributions, community services, volunteer work, and humanitarianism.

Mabel Hoggard was the first Black teacher hired in the State of Nevada where she distinguished herself as a dedicated educator. She taught successfully at many schools until her retirement. Before coming to Las Vegas she was a teaching Principal in Jenkins, Kentucky, and Delbarton, School, Mingo County, West Virginia. She was a member of the Administrative staff of the Public Housing Author-

ity of Williamson, West Virginia.

She was honored by Las Vegas Rotary as the "Honor Teacher of the Week." As chairman of the Westside Council in 1969 Mrs. Hoggard worked with a coalition of the six Westside elementary schools and was instrumental in influencing Clark County School District Trustees in establishing a district-wide lunch program.

She was instrumental in organizing a savings program for young people through the NAACP at the Westside Credit Union. Her laurels are more than we can mention at this time.

David Hoggard was a Clark County School District attendance officer from 1953-1965. He later was appointed

member of the first Board of Directors of the Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County. He served as Program Assistant, Program Coordinator, Deputy Director-Coordinator and Executive Director, a position which he held from 1968 to 1982.

He was a former President of the NAACP and is also a Life Member. Hoggard has served on many boards in this community for its betterment. Some are Operation Independence, Economic Opportunity Board, and he was a charter member of Zion United Methodist Church where he is a trustee and was appointed by the Governor to the State Manpower Services Council which he served from 1974 to 1982. His credits are too numerous to
