

Rev. Dunn faces charges of striking SUN Reporter Palm

According to the Las Vegas Sun, one of its reporters, Bob Palm, has filed battery charges against Rev. Albert Dunn, who the journalist said attacked him as he tried to leave the New Town Tavern, 600 West Jackson, on Tuesday morning.

The Sun report indicated that the crime report was filed hours after the 10:20 a.m. incident at the New Town Tavern where Dunn allegedly stopped Palm and asked him if he wrote an item about him that appeared in Jeffrey M. German's "Inside Story" column Tuesday.

Palm told the minister, convicted in federal court for his involvement in a \$10 million counterfeiting conspiracy, that he did not write the news item (The German article read: "The turnout was light Sunday at

the fund raiser in west Las Vegas for North Las Vegas Municipal Judge Gary Davis. But, a few notables managed to show up. The Rev. Albert Dunn was the emcee and ex-Laborers Union boss George Osley delivered the keynote address. Both men are convicted felons...").

As bar owner Elija Green stepped between the two, the suspect struck Palm with his left fist, Palm told police.

As Palm attempted to walk out again, the suspect stepped between the reporter and the door, and grabbed and shook him repeatedly.

As the victim left, the other man threatened him, Palm said.

Palm told police he was suffering from an injured jaw as a result of the attack.
