Undisputed World light heavyweight champion Michael Spinks and World Boxing Council cruiserweight king Carlos "Sugar" DeLeon highlight the "D-Day Dynamite" championship doubleheader card Thursday, June 6, at the Riviera Hotel and Casino.

The undefeated Spinks meets unbeaten slugger "Diamond" Jim "Big Mac" MacDonald for the World 175-pound title while DeLeon faces 6-foot-5-inch and No. 1-ranked Alfonzo Ratliff for the 195-pound crown. Both bouts are 12 rounds.

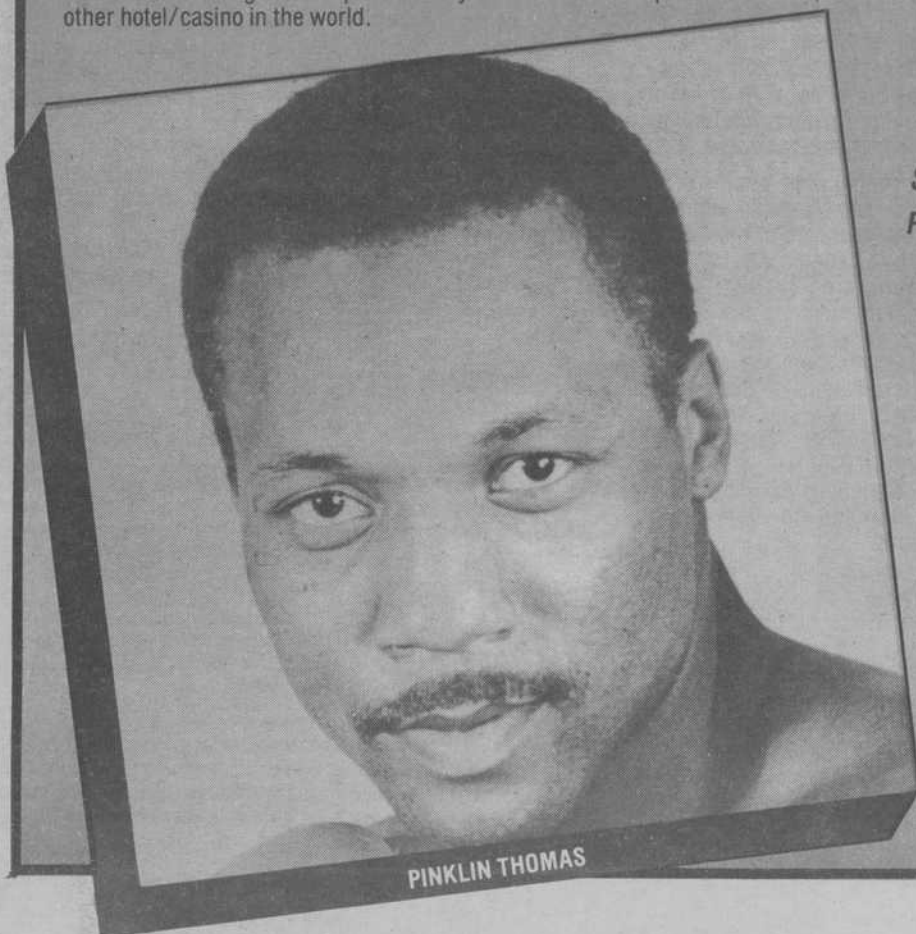
Undefeated Pinklon Thomas makes his first defense of the World Boxing Council heavyweight championship on Saturday, June 15, at the Riviera Hotel and Casino against former World Boxing Association heavyweight king and current No. 1 contender Mike Weaver.

The 12-round title bout will be held in the Riviera's SuperStar Center and will be the third championship fight to be held at the famed resort hotel/casino within 10 days. It's also the ninth world title fight to be promoted by the Riviera in the past 15 months, more than any other hotel/casino in the world.

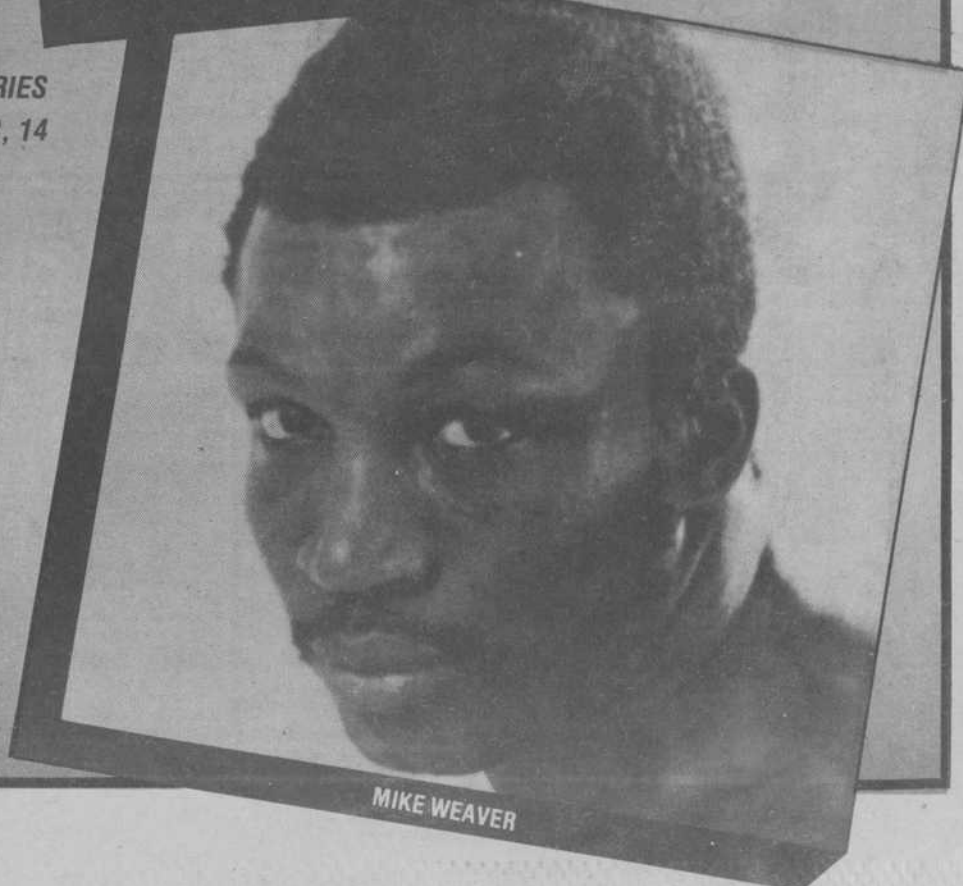
