### Health Risk Questionnaire Results Still Available

If you completed a health risk questionnaire during the health fair but missed the appraisal sessions, your results are still available at the Clark County Health District, 625 Shadow Lane in Las Vegas.

Health educators will assist in interpreting computerized results if you schedule an appointment by calling 383-1217, Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or results will be mailed at your request.

The questionnaire surveyed health habits and lifestyle in order to assess individual health risks. Using the analysis, health educators are able to identify specific health problems and provide appropriate health counseling.
