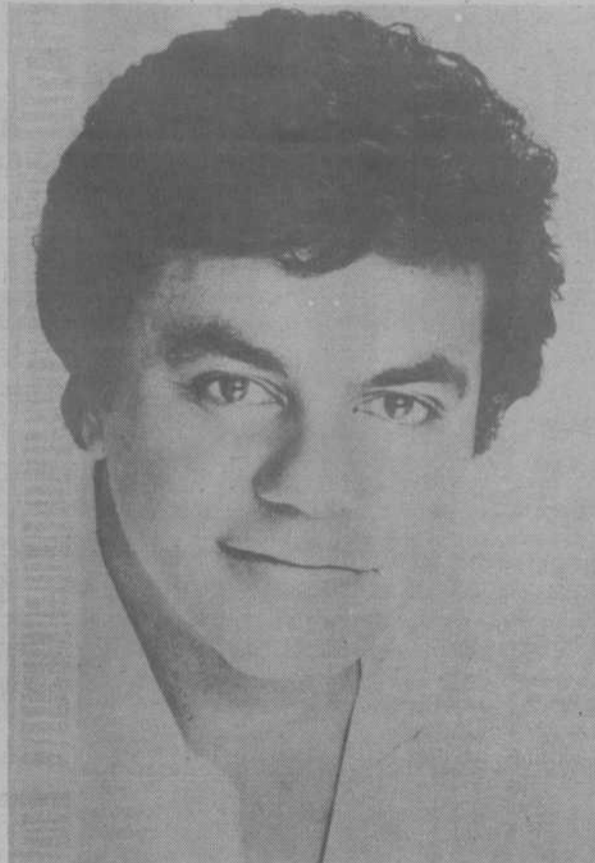
theme from daytime drama "Ryan's Hope;" the lyrics were written especially for Johnny.
