Black parents, do you really love your children? If you really love them, then why do you treat them so badly and allow others to do the same?

Under all of the laws of God and man, you have the full responsibility to see that your children are fed, clothed, sheltered and educated — both spiritually and secularly.

If you say you love your children, when is the last time you went to the school and talked to your children's teacher and principal about your children's discipline in school, their study habits, their ability to read, write and do mathematics?

Do you know that your children are graduating from high school and don't have the ability to fill out an employment application? Do you know that your tax

dollars pay the Superintendent's Principal's and teachers' salaries?

Integration: Clark County style

Busing Black children out of the area where they live for eleven years and white children into West Las Vegas for one year of their grade school years is unfair.

Although the NAACP initially agreed to this plan of token integration, it is, at best, still unfair for Blacks, because they did not cause the housing patterns to be segregated in Las Vegas in the first place.

No matter how good or how bad any plan is, it should be reviewed, assessed and reevaluated so that everyone will know its effect and the impact it has had on the people involved.

Since the so-called sixth grade plan has been in

operation more than 12 years, it is time to take a look-see, an agonizing appraisal, if you will, of Black education in Clark County in 1985.

Blacks Badly Need Religious Education

Most people don't know that religious-based education is much more important than public or secular education, for their children and for themselves as well.

If only you would study your Bible, you would know that the family came before the church. God in his majesty established Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden before the Day of the Pentecost or the New Testament Church.

The Jews and the Mormons, both of these religious sects, believe very strongly in family ties and family relations. I'm told that both of these groups get their children up early in the morning and take them to religious education institutes, hours before they go to public school.

NLV Robbery Suspect killed after holdup

A North Las Vegas robbery suspect was shot to death Tuesday night after allegedly threatening the wife of a North Las Vegas business owner and stealing money, North Las Vegas Police said.

David Curry, 25, was shot once in the back of the head after he reportedly held up the TNT Laundromat at 608 W. Lake Mead Blvd about 6 p.m., said Detective Nancy Earle.

Curry had reportedly held a knife to the throat of Emily Dooley, 44, and demanded money from John Dooley, owner of the laundromat, Earle said.

After obtaining an unknown amount of cash, Curry fled across a nearby field with John Dooley in pursuit, Earle said.

During the chase, Dooley, 44, stopped to grab a .22-caliber rifle from the trunk of his car. Three shots were fired from the gun, one of which hit Curry in the back of the head, killing him, Earle said.

No charges were filed pending an investigation.
