Senator Jesse Helms, who suffers from a chronic infection of anti-Black and the only medication he takes is an anti-Soviet serum, said that sanctions would turn the entire African continent over to the communists. He spoke of how someone went to a meeting of South Africans and everyone was against sanctions; Zimbabwe is a Marxist country; and that the riot in Washington in the sixties was very costly because of putting down violence, and that is what is now going on in South Africa — just curbing violence. His statement aroused no comment other than from

Sen. Mathias, who said that congressmen must be careful in making statements.

The conference voted out a sanctions bill which bans, immediately, Krugerrand sales and the sale of computers to South Africa, with a 12 month waiting period on prohibiting new investments, to be determined by South Africa's movement toward the elimination of apartheid.

The bill will have to go before both Houses. Senator Dole said it might face a filibuster in the Senate, but he feels that he will be able to get a cloture vote. If it is passed, the president's position on the bill still

remains to be seen.

Sanctions by the United States, by 13 other countries and the recall of the South African ambassador all had its origin in Randall Robinson, coupled with Dr. Mary Berry, Representative Walter Fauntroy and many other Black American notables going to jail. These things have been done in less than a year's time — once we started speaking up.
