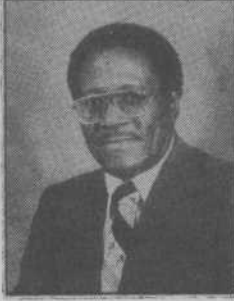

Las Vegas — A Tale of Two Cities

One is white and the other one is black. It is a city where racism is boss. There is white justice and black injustice.

The Greater Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce and the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority want Las Vegas to be portrayed as the mecca of entertainment, fun and goodwill for all

humanity. Tens of millions of dollars are spent each year on advertisement and public relations in the United States and around the world, inviting tourists to come to the Entertainment Capitol of the World.

The tourists that are invited to come here are white, black, yellow and red. They come here believing Las Vegas is an international city on the order of Mexico

City or the Hawaiian Islands. However, they are shocked on their arrival to find that Las Vegas is a city reeking with racism and leads the nation in separatism and race hatred!

Injustice — Scott Sloane vs. Henry Dawson

Scott Sloane, a white man and Henry Dawson, a Black man, each attacked and murdered two ladies at different times and in different places. Both of them were apprehended, jailed, indicted and finally convicted for committing the heinous crime of murder in the first degree.

The evidence showed that both of them did some harm to their victims before they finally murdered them. However, apparently Scott Sloane did more to his victim.

Both of them allegedly engaged in acts that were deliberate and were done with premeditation and malice aforethought.

Both were tried by juries that were all or nearly all white and this is where the similarities ended.

Scott Sloane was sentenced to life in prison with the possibility of parole and Henry Dawson was sentenced to death by lethal injection.

Another Las Vegas jury, in the case of Airman George DeBose, who was locked in a Montgomery Ward store, ignored the evidence and ruled in favor of a Metro Policeman. The public is outraged over this miscarriage of justice. If the Sloane/Dawson cases had not been tried during the same period of time and the jury decisions had not been

handed down two days apart, maybe the general public would have noticed them.

Many calls have come into the NAACP office pointing out how blatant racism is in Las Vegas and wanting to know what they could do about it. These calls come from whites, blacks and Spanish-American people.

The callers have been told that after Judge Earle White sentences Dawson, they could send messages to Governor Richard Bryan, State Supreme Court Justice Al Gunderson and the U.S. Department of Justice expressing their displeasure and anger.

Computing Technology Offered

Purpose: Recent trends in office automation have been made possible by the power of personal computers and the software packages available on them. Current projections indicate that almost 50 percent of all "offices" will employ microprocessor workstations by the end of the decade.

This course is primarily intended for the CIT major who is interested in the design and "selection" aspects of such systems, and the underlying technical issues involved; however, the course also provides broad exposure to those needing to re-train or upgrade as a "user" in a typical office. CIT prerequisites are highly recommended, but can be waived by consent of the instructor.

... classroom demos and tutorials in microlab software) An Integrated Automated Office consists of one or more microprocessor based "workstations," often interconnected by a "local area network" and frequently also connected to an external "global" network. The major functions automated at the local workstation level include word-processing, automated accounting, spread sheet preparation and printing, graphics output, data base management and automated office administration. The major functions automated on a global level include electronic mail, file transfers between non-homogeneous offices or systems, and distributed processing (sharing resources and systems, and sharing large databases between user installations.

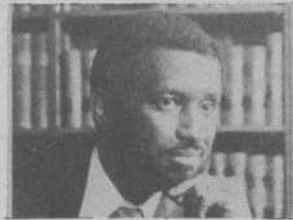
