Sammy Davis Jr. a member of the NAACP National Life Membership Committee remembers the days when he along with Josephine Baker, Lena Horne, Pearl Bailey and other Black Stars could not live in the Strip Hotels where they performed.

Before the NAACP opened the doors of the Strip Hotels through the threat of mass demonstrations, Sammy recalls how all Black stars had to live in West Las Vegas or in trailers in the parking lots of major hotels.

In those days, Black stars could not be patrons of the hotels nor, could they make use of the swimming pool facilities where performed.

The story is told how the late great Josephine Baker,

an international theatrical star and the toast of Paris, refused to do the last show one night in the fifties at Rancho Vegas until management went out and brought some Black patrons in as her guests into the showroom.
