

Mr. Peanut Balloon To Be Featured At NLV Fairshow

Is it a bird? Is it a plane? No . . . it's a PEANUT! — Mr. Peanut to be exact. This famous balloon created by Cameron Balloons Ltd. of Bristol, England, will take to the air at the North Las Vegas Fairshow, October 25,

26 and 27 at the Clark County Community College. Since its maiden flight in 1980, this balloon, a replica of the Planters Peanut trademark adopted in 1916, has appeared at numerous events in England, Scotland

and the United States. When fully inflated, Mr. Peanut stands over 100 feet tall and is more than 36 feet wide. Air heated by liquid propane gas inflates and lifts the craft and its pilot, Eric Barnum, to an altitude of 1500 feet.

Mr. Peanut will be on display Friday, October 25 at the Fairshow balloon field along with many of the other balloon entries in the Nevada Championship Hot Air Balloon Races. The races are scheduled for October 26 and

27. Many other activities are planned for all members of the family from "Prince" and "Princess" contests for

the small fry to the Bizarre Bazaar and Beer Garden. The admission is free. For additional information, call 642-1944.
