1985 International Holiday Mailing Dates Scheduled

For those with relatives in the armed services stationed overseas, and those who wish to mail holiday greetings and packages to others living in foreign countries, now is the time to plan for holiday mailings, according to the U.S. Postal Service.

Parcels sent to military personnel in Australia, the Far East and Southeast Asia have to be mailed by Oct. 18 if shipped by surface mail, the least expensive form of shipment.

November is the month when most parcels shipped via Parcel Airlift Mail (PAL) should be sent. PAL packages are airlifted domestically to a gateway facility, then airlifted on a space available basis from the gateway to the APO (Army or Air Force Post Office).

Packages up to 30 pounds and 60 inches in combined length and girth may be sent by PAL. Mailers pay the by PAL and Parcel Package to the regular Parcel Post rate to the U.S. exit port or from the port of entry plus a fee for air service. The air service fee is cents for parcels weighing two pounds or less, 60 cents for two to three

pounds, 90 cents for three to four pounds, and \$1.20 for four to 30 pounds.

regular Parcel Post rates to the U.S. exit port or from the U.S. port of entry.

When mailed from a

combined length and girth military post office outside may be sent by SAM for the 48 contiguous states, the weight of any piece cannot be more than 70 pounds and the size cannot exceed 100 inches in length and girth combined.


