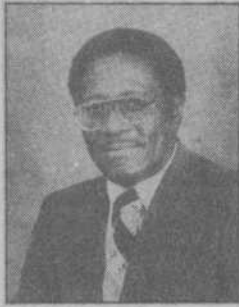

CCSD Provides Sunset Evening High School

Sunset Evening High School is a fully accredited regular high school operated by the Clark County School District for students who cannot attend regular day high school.

Sunset's school hours, 3:30 p.m. to 10 p.m., can accommodate the special needs of students who have

to work during day hours, who have children to care for or who have other personal reasons why they are unable to attend regular day high school.

Students enrolled at Sunset High School may attend a full class schedule of required and elective courses such as business,

home economics, trades and industry and fine arts. A commencement, or graduation, ceremony is held each spring to honor those students who have earned their high school diplomas. Included in the ceremony are presentations by valedictorian and salutarian, and recognition of good

citizenship winners and college scholarship recipients.

Sunset High School is located on the campus of Hyde Park Junior High School, 950 Hinson St. Registration dates for the 1985-86 school year correspond to the quarter report periods.
