

SOME OF NEVADA POINTS OF INTEREST

HAWTHORNE, NEVADA - Headquarters for fishermen attracted to WALKER LAKE for its famed cutthroat trout. **HAWTHORNE ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT** is located there -- the principal source of employment for the near 5,000 residents. The Sentinel-Voice can be picked up weekly at the Nu Way Cleaners in Hawthorne, owned by Clarence Blanks.

TONOPAH, NEVADA -- Silver mining boom began there in 1900 when Jim Butler's mule raked loose a nugget to start the rush. This week Tonopah is booming and the hotels are full of movie stars who are in the midst of a major film being shot in the town. The Sentinel-Voice can be picked up weekly at the Tonopah Chamber of Commerce and Mines office at 112 Browgher ave.

CARSON CITY, NEVADA -- The State Capital, named for Kit Carson. Located there are most of the state agencies; the State Museum (formerly a U.S. Mint), the State Library, the Supreme Court; and the familiar silverdomed Capitol Building constructed in the 1870's from native sandstone.

RENO, NEVADA -- Principal commercial, cultural community in northern Nevada and state's second largest city. Home of the University of Nevada, Reno. Gateway to the Sierra's winter sports areas at Mt. Rose Slide Mountain and land. This has produced a hardship for many of the present residents.

Squaw Valley. It is one of the biggest gaming centers in the state of Nevada. The Sentinel-Voice Reno manager is Delores Feemster who can be reached at (702) 323-3677. HENDERSON, NEVADA -- Chief industrial community in Southern Nevada. Producer of magnesium during World War III. Facilities now being used for chemical production and allied industry. One will be able to pick up copies weekly at these locations in Henderson: Highland Village Apartments at 301 Taylor street and the 7-11 store at 710 Center.

LAS VEGAS, NEVADA -- Nevada's largest city. A prominent tourist attraction with its famed strip hotels and spectacular convention center. It is also the site of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. The Sentinel-Voice is distributed weekly to more than 140 locations throughout the city.

Among some of the current outstanding landmarks at Black Springs include the Martin Luther King Center built in 1984 replacing an old building destroyed by fire. Visitors to Black Springs are impressed with the name of the streets. Included are Kennedy Drive, Coretta Way, Medgar Avenue, Malcolm Street and of course, Westbrook Lane named after
