POSTAL SERVICE ANNOUNCES EFFORTS TO LOCATE MISSING CHILDREN

The U.S. Postal Service, in conjunction with the National Association of Letter Carriers, announced today a coordinated, voluntary effort to locate missing children.

A statement of support for the "Child Alert" program was signed today by Postmaster General Paul N. Carlin, National Association of Letter Carriers President Vincent R. Sombrotto, and Jay Howell, Executive Director of the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children.

In remarks before the signing ceremony, Carlin noted that there are some 220,000 city letter carriers nationwide. neghborhoods and on city streets, those carriers come into contact with millions of our nation's children on a daily basis,'' said Carlin, adding, ''We have every reason to hope that they can play a significant role in locating missing children."

Participation by letter carriers is strictly voluntary. Said union President Sombrotto, "In teaming up with the Postal Service in 'Child Alert,' the National Association of Letter Carriers and its membership are again demonstrating their community spirit and their deep concern for the people they serve.

Six photographs of missing children will be published each month in Postal Service and union publications. Pictures published in the Postal Bulletin will be posted in post office lobbies nationwide for public viewing. Those photographs printed in union publications will remind carriers to be on the lookout for missing children as they make deliveries to over 72 million addresses every business day.

"We don't expect carriers to memorize pictures of missing children," said Howell, "but it is quite possible that a letter carrier will recognize a child seen earlier on their route."


