### Black Teen-age Pregnancy Three Times As High

Overall, the American teen-age pregnancy rate is higher than that of any other industrialized nation. By their 18th birthday, 22 percent of Black females have become mothers as compared to 8 percent of White females. For every 1,000 Black teen-age girls, there are 163 pregnancies. In 1982, Black teens had 145,929 births, 87 percent of them out of wedlock.

### An Idea Whose Time Has Come

Certainly, the NUL and the NAACP deserve much credit for sponsoring a conference that led to a concerted focus on the Black male's role in teen-age pregnancies. Nonetheless, the root of the predicament is the lack of "togetherness" by the masses of Blacks in mutual respect of, and in support for, each other. This supportive togetherness is the major idea behind AOIP.

incomes derive from non-corporate sources.

Instead of highlighting what one would think is a scary finding for conservatives, reports stressed that the poll shows 30 percent of all blacks backing Reagan. Then why did fewer than ten percent vote for him, a figure more in line with other, more reliable polls.

And anyone knows that the way you word a question will tilt the response. That helps account for the poll's results on affirmative action. The question's loaded terminology got the response the poll's authors were looking for.

The fact is that black leadership reflects the attitudes of the black majority, despite attempts to drive a wedge between black organizations and their constituents. This is confirmed by other polls and by the best poll of all — the vote.

The black community is far from monolithic and it has pluralistic leadership at least as representative of the views of the black mainstream as white leadership is of the white population.

## Silver Camp of Nevada

### Important things to remember about Tonopah

#### Jim Butler -- Tonopah's founder

The town that was to become "Queen of the Silver Camps" had an unusual beginning.

While prospecting in the desert in 1900, legend has it Jim Butler got mad at his burro. He grabbed a rock to sling at the troublesome jackass. But, the rock felt heavy -- like silver -- so he didn't throw it.

Too broke to pay for an assay, Butler's appeals for an assay on a share basis established fortunes, built Tonopah, put Nevada on its feet, sent a Senator to Washington, created a great political organization, helped rebuild San Francisco after the earthquake and fire, and started a series of great mining booms.

All of this because Jim Butler got mad at his burro one day and happened to be in the right place.

#### Jim Butler Days --

Jim Butler is still remembered in Tonopah during the Annual Jim Butler Days Celebration held over Memorial Day Weekend in late May. Locals and visitors enjoy a wide range of activities during this fun-filled weekend -- everything from drilling contests, barbeques, and a parade.

#### Mining in the area --

Tonopah grew amidst the gallows frames and ore dumps which are an indication of the feverish underground activity that has carved an estimated 100 miles of tunnelling under the City and has produced over \$200,000,000 in precious metals, chiefly silver. And, it is here, just a few yards from the main highway, where Jim Butler made the discovery that electrified the mining

world. The Anaconda Corporation has recently begun mining operations near Tonopah which has created many new exciting opportunities in the area.

#### Exploring yesterday

Tonopah has many of the original structures that were built in the early 1900's. This, along with the many ghost towns within a short driving distance, make the area a photographers paradise.

#### Convention center

The Tonopah Convention Center is centrally located just off Main Street on Brougner Avenue. This modern facility hosts many local groups and is a popular meeting place for many statewide functions.

#### City park --

Tonopah offers a warm, friendly atmosphere, plenty

of fresh air and lots of sunshine. The City Park is a great place to meet friends for tennis, swimming, barbeques, or just plain relaxing in the sun.
