Today, Congressman Walter E. Fauntroy joined the Washington Office On Africa at a press conference to announce their opposition to providing assistance to South African backed insurgents in Angola seeking to overthrow that country's government.

Speaking for the twenty members of Congressional Black Caucus (CBC); Congressman Fauntroy said, "We believe that any such assistance

whether covert or overt, would definitely ally the United States with South Africa's racist regime. To aid in the war against the people of Angola and Namibia would compromise our policy of pressuring South Africa to end apartheid and its illegal occupation of Namibia, and threaten American interests throughout Africa.

"Support for assistance to South African supported National Union for the Total Independence of Angola (UNITA) would undo all the good we have accomplished in the Congress with the Anti-Apartheid Act of 1985, 1460,'' H.R. stated Fauntroy. He identified UNITA as playing a combat role inside Angola and involved with numerous ground and air assaults from their bases in illegally occupied Namibia.

As Chairman of the CBC Voter Braintrust on Participation and Network Development, Congressman

Fauntroy announced that he and CBC Chairman Mickey Leland will activate the Action Alert Network to resist these unwise proposals.

The CBC is encouraging Members of Congress to co-sponsor a bill to be introduced next week by Congressman Ted Weiss (D-N.Y.) that would prohibit assistance for military or paramilitary operations in Angola.
