

Ali says white champs needed to help boxing

Muhammad Ali says white champions could improve the status of professional

The 43-year-old former world heavyweight titlist said the sport 'needs a couple of white champions, maybe a heavyweight and middleweight.

'White and good, because people who follow boxing identify with a champion, All said in an interview with The Wednesday Oregonian.

When Max Schmeling was fighting, all the Germans were excited because they associated with Schmeling, he said. "And with (Rocky) Marciano, the Italians would cheer and wave their arms."

Same with Jack Johnson and Jack Dempsey and Joe Louis," Ali said. "People are excited to see their own champion. But right now all the champions are black. All contenders are black.

'I've always spoken the truth about my religion and said Ali, my racial feelings,' "Boxing a black Muslim. needs some good white champions. It would bring the whole thing alive.

"The white people are the wealthiest, and they will fill the arena. But they have no champion. It would be the same thing if there was a 7foot heavyweight from China. All the Chinese would want him to be champion.'

Asked who was the best heavyweight of all time, Ali smiled and said, "I said 'me' when I was boxing, but that was just to sell tickets. Now I'm telling you it was Jack Johnson. All around, he was the best.
