Blacks, The Silent Minority In Clark County

The 1980 Census Statistics show that there are thousands of Blacks living in Clark County many of whom have moved here recently but have not come forward to identify with or join their other Black sisters and brothers in the struggle for Freedom.

These individuals cover the entire demographic spectrum. Among them are doctors, lawyers, engineers, bankers, teachers, preachers, carpenters, plumbers, cement masons, painters, building contractors, salesmen, nurses, social workers, photographers, technicians, singers, writers, dancers, actors, musicians, senior citizens, counselors, advisors, scientists, housewives, labors, college professors, school principles, employment and personnel specialists, test site, federal contractors employees, planners, shopkeepers, mechanics, transportation companies, entrepreneurs and publishers.

Among these individuals many of them are in the \$40,000 and above annual salary range.

The NAACP invites these people to come back home and rejoin the Fight For Freedom.

Philadelphia Bottling Co. Becomes First Black-Owned Coca-Cola Bottler

PHILADELPHIA, Pa. — December 18, 1985 — A business transaction completed here today provides for the first majority-held black ownership of a Coca-Cola bottling company — the Philadelphia Coca-Cola Bottling Company — one of the nation's largest and most successful soft drink bottlers.

A group of investors under the direction of J. Bruce Llewellyn and Julius "Dr. J." Erving purchased Philadelphia Coke from The Coca-Cola Company and The Coca-Cola Bottling Company of New York, Inc.

Under the management of the Llewellyn-Erving investor group, Philadelphia Coke, according to Black Enterprise magazine's 1984 annual list of the top 100 black businesses, will become the fourth largest U.S. black-owned business in terms of sales, behind Johnson Publishing Company, Inc., Motown Industries and H.J. Russell Construction, Inc.

"Throughout the years, we have sought to provide minority firms with a fair position in the U.S. marketplace overall and especially within our own operations," said Donald R.

Keough, president and chief operating officer, The Coca-Cola Company. "We are proud to extend the ownership of not only one of our largest soft drink bottling companies, but also one of the largest in the entire soft drink industry as well, to the Llewellyn-Erving investor group."

Erving became a New York Coke shareholder in 1984. At that time, both investors represented the largest minority ownership position of a bottling company in the U.S. soft drink industry. With today's acquisition, Mr. Erving will be a significant shareholder while also supporting the Philadelphia company in a variety of marketing roles.

Erving, star forward of the Philadelphia 76ers who is better known to sports enthusiasts as "Dr. J.," is one of the greatest players in the history of professional basketball. He also has served as a spokesman for Coca-Cola.
