Yarrington, 44, was taken into custody on charges of destruction of evidence, possession of cocaine with intent to sell, conspiracy to distribute cocaine and possession of drug paraphernalia. Kenneth Scott, 46, was arrested on charges of conspiracy, destruction of evidence and possession of drug paraphernalia, police said.

The other suspects were arrested on charges of conspiracy and possession of durg paraphernalia.
