Between July, 1977 and July, 1985, this writer has written scores of articles which have appeared in the Las Vegas Sentinel-Voice Newspaper, encouraging property owners in our area to spruce up, fix up, paint up, and clean up our properties. And for six straight years the Mayor of the City of Las Vegas, in cooperation with the Westside Community Commission has declared the month of May as "Clean Up Month in West Las Vegas.

Not only does cleaning up and painting up our properties make them more attractive, sanitary and healthful, but it also increases the value of our real estate, which is our single most important


