The City of Las Vegas is eligible to receive from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development an allocation of \$1,574,000 in Fiscal Year 1986-1987 Community Development Block Grant Entitlement monies. The Citizen Advisory Review Board recommendations are as follows:

DESCRIPTION OF USE OF CDBG ENTITLEMENT FUNDS EXPENDED SINCE 1985-86 FINAL STATEMENT

Over \$633,570.00 in CDBG monies have been expended to revitalize the housing stock in the ten targeted census tracts; improve and expand services to the physically and mentally handicapped; devise mechanisms to improve the level of health services available to low to moderate income residents; decrease the isolation of lower income elderly and handicapped residents by providing low cost transportation to needed service centers; and, replace and rehabilitate dilapidated housing units for low income families.
