



NAACP to hold Cross Country March for human dignity

Dr. Benjamin Hooks, the Executive Director of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People and his National Board of Directors, have decreed that there shall be a cross country march staged by the NAACP beginning in Los Angeles, California on Sunday June 1 and ending in Baltimore, Maryland Sunday June 29--the opening of the 77th Annual National Convention.

The purpose of the march is to dramatize the NAACP's Commitment for Human Dignity in South Africa and at home, and to register people to vote. Joseph Madison, the National Director of Voter Education and Attorney Gary Davis, the March Coordinator, will begin the march, Monday June 2 at 3:00 p.m. in front of the Hacienda Hotel on the Strip to the federal building on Las Vegas Blvd, South and Bridger Street, where a press conference will be held.
