## Political sign laws to be enforced

A state law controlling placement of roadside political signs will be strictly enforced according to Deputy Director Garth Dull of the Nevada Department of

Transportation (NDOT). Under the law, NRS 405.10, signs are not permitted in state right-ofway land by highways, and owners will be given a oneweek removal notice.

Signs that pose safety hazards will be removed immediately.

Rules also address use of signs on private land surrounding highways.

NRS 410.400 states that a sign cannot be put up more
