## Vucanovich mail probe requested

RENO—Washoe County Democratic Party Chairman Jack Schroeder is calling for investigations on two fronts into possible mailing violations by Rep. Barbara Vucanovich, R-Nev.

Schroeder said a December fundraising letter contained a likeness of the great seal of the United States, which could violate the law. He also charged that a December newsletter was too political to allow her to use her franking privilege. The complaints, filed June

10, were made public at a news conference on Monday. Schroeder asked the Justice Department to investigate the use of the great seal on the fund-raising letter.

The commission dismissed that complaint last week in a 3-2 vote along party lines.

## Bryan announces SNEPT award for Summer Youth Program

CARSON CITY — Governor Richard Bryan announced that \$1,545,355 will be awarded to Southern Nevada

Employment and Training Program for the Summer Youth Program, providing summer jobs for about 1,300 young Nevadans.

The Summer Youth Program is one of the many fine examples of programs funded by the Job Training Partnership Act. The program is for young people between 14 and 21.

For most participants, it is their first exposure to the working world. Pre-employment workshops are held in local high schools where participants learn how to fill out applications, job search and interviewing skills, how to be successful and retain a job and what they can expect in the local job market.

## Hamilton selected Carson City manager

CARSON CITY — Lynnwood "Lynn" Hamilton, city manager of La Grande, Ore., was selected as city manager by the Carson City Board of Supervisors.

Hamilton, 38, will earn \$50,000 a year and receive a \$3,000 a year car allowance. He beat out the other finalist, Edward Barrett, assistant city manager of Wichita Falls, Texas. Hamilton will succeed Donald Hataway who was bounced from the job last year.

He says one of his first priorities will be to tackle the budget problems. The city's \$13 million budget will have a reserve of only \$27,000 at the end of fiscal year July 1, 1987.

given to cash-starved black colleges to help them revamp their curriculum and establish graduate schools in education to train students for certification?

What will be done to assist current black teachers to gain accreditation and get the additional training required for Lead Teacher positions and to participate in school administration?

What will be done to broaden the numbers of blacks in the pool of potential teachers — by cutting school dropout rates, raising aspirations, improving the quality of secondary education to ensure that more blacks go on to college, and helping disadvantaged minorities afford college costs?

The report implies a massive transfer of resources to education in a time of austerity, so the reforms could take place without necessary investments that would assure black participation.

A *Nation Prepared* has some bold answers to education reform issues — but is our nation prepared to implement those answers so that minorities share in the outcome?

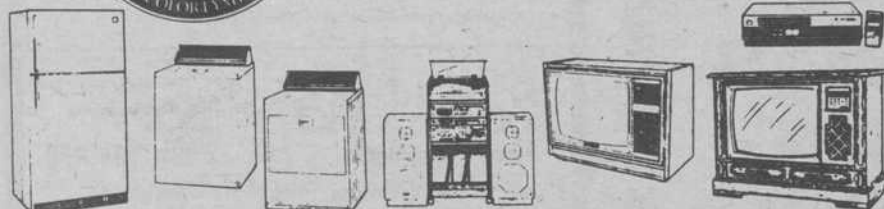

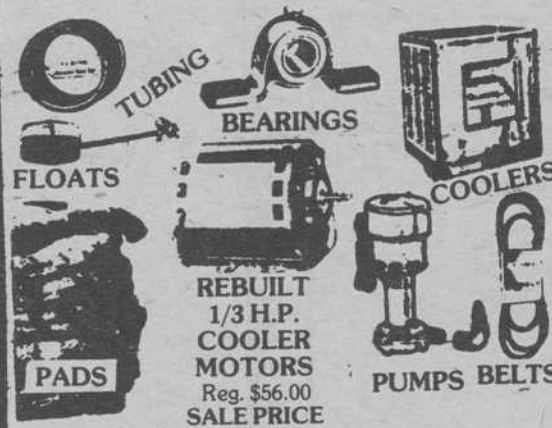
