Justice Department to investigate the use of the great seal on the fund-raising letter The commission dismissed


that complaint last week in a 3-2 vote along party lines.



given to cash-starved black colleges to help them revamp curriculum and their establish graduate schools in education to train students for certification?

What will be done to assist current black teachers to gain accreditation and get the additional training required for Lead Teacher positions and to participate in school administration?

What will be done to broaden the numbers of blacks in the pool of potential teachers - by cutting school dropout rates, raising aspirations, improving the quality of secondary education to ensure that more blacks go on to college, and helping disadvantaged minorities afford college costs?


The report implies a massive transfer of resources to education in a time of austerity, so the reforms could take place necessary investments that would assure black participation.
