Elko hospital rates rise

ELKO — Rates for many services at Elko General Hospital will increase an average of 4.9 percent.

Hospital administrator Bill Welch said that along with adoption of the 1986-87 fiscal year budget and the long-range plan, trustees approved the rate increase that goes into effect July 1.

The hospital budget for 1986-87 totals slightly less than \$7 million and includes a four percent cost-of-living increase for hospital employees.

Welch noted that some hospital departments, such as emergency room and surgery, will have no rate increase at all, while others will have increases up to 6 percent. The overall increase will be 4.9 percent, he explained.

2 face hearing after beating

Two men suspected of beating, robbing and possibly shooting a Reno man in Dog Valley, near Verdi, June 12 face a preliminary hearing in Sierra Justice Court in Downieville, Calif., June 30.

Donald Violes, 38, and Jon Schuetz, 25, both of Hot Springs, Ark., were arrested in Sacramento June 14 and arraigned Tuesday. They are held in lieu of \$100,000 bail each on charges of attempted murder, robbery, conspiracy, possession of stolen property and vehicle theft.

Victim Gary B. Thrun, 40, is in Saint Mary's Hospital, recovering from fractures of the skull, hand and ribs.

He told officers he was camped with the men when they beat him with a tire iron

and robbed and shot him. Sierra County Sheriff's Sgt. Steve Peterson said Wednesday that Voiles and Schuetz denied shooting Thrun and it has not been determined if he was shot.

Carson City girl, 6, drowns in Walker

A 6-year-old Carson City girl drowned Saturday afternoon in the fast-running Walker River between Yerington and Smith Valley, a Lyon County Sheriff's Department dispatcher said.

The girl, whose name is being withheld pending notification of her father, was attempting to cross the river near the Wilson Canyon Bridge when the 3 p.m. accident occurred, Lyon County dispatcher Joanne Sanford said.

The girl's mother told investigators she tried to stop her daughter from entering the river, but the daughter kept trying to cross. The mother tried to grab the girl but was unable to keep her grip due to the fast current, Sanford said.

The girl's body was found at 5:10 p.m. about six miles down river from where the accident occurred. She was pronounced dead at the scene.

The Lyon County Sheriff's Department was assisted in its rescue attempt by the Yerington Police Department, the Yerington Volunteer Fire Department and the Smith Valley Volunteer Fire Department.
