Pointer Sisters Return To Caesars Palace



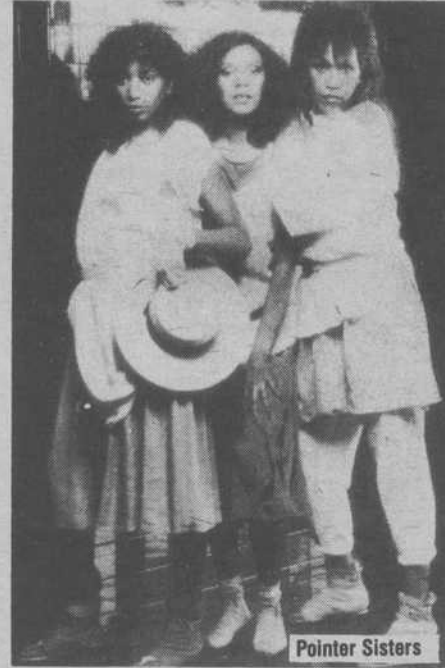
The Pointer Sisters will headline in the Circus Maximus Showroom at Caesars Palace when they come to Las Vegas July 16-28, directly from their engagement at Caesars Atlantic City. Following the Caesars Palace dates, the group will continue with a concert tour in the East and Midwest. The sisters — Anita, Ruth and June — have a new album in the works, as yet unnamed, which should be ready for release this fall.

As teenagers, the three began with gospel music and later moved on to blues, jazz, soul, country and rock as they explored the music world. Now singing high-energy pop/rock, they have achieved five gold albums, two gold singles and

one triple-platinum album. They won two Grammy

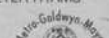
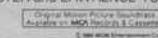
