
Business and Political Leaders Showcased At NBL

WASHINGTON - Nationally known television host and journalist, Tony Brown, Congressional Black Caucus Chairman, Representative Mickey Leland, New Orleans Mayor, Sidney Barthelemy and MBDA Director, James H. Richardson Gonzales were just a few of the many political and business leaders that participated in The National Business League's Founder's Day Dinner and "Pilot Buy Freedom Weekend."

The weekend agenda which included the NBL Founder's Day Dinner held at the Fairmont Hotel in New Orleans, A Leadership Breakfast and a rally kicking off "Pilot Buy Freedom Program," was the first joint effort between the NBL and the Council for the Economic Development of Black Americans.

According to Arthur E. Teele, Jr., president and CEO of the NBL, "This is just the first phase of our fiveyear plan which is designed to make economic selfsufficiency the main thrust of our membership constituency.

Teele further stated that the plan stresses economic self help and self development, harnessing black spending power and building a stronger economic infrastructure in the black community.

Brown, who was the keynote speaker at the Founder's Day Dinner and the Leadership Breakfast, outlined the goals of the Buy Freedom program, "Buy Freedom's goal is for blacks to make half their purchases


