

National Black Police Association To Hold 14th Annual Conference

The National Black Police Association, which represents over 35,000 Black Police Officers across the nation, will hold its fourteenth annual conference in Las Vegas, Nevada August 17 through August 23, 1986. Conference headquarters will be Caesars Palace Hotel, 3570 Las Vegas Boulevard, South, Las Vegas, Nevada.

The theme for this year's educational conference is "Balance the Scale of Justice." Conference activities will be highlighted by seminars dealing with such issues as substance abuse, human rights training, corrections, and recent Supreme Court decisions and their impact on Black police officers. Addressing the conference delegates will be an array of distinguished speakers from across the country.

The purpose of the National Black Police Association is to promote justice, fairness and

effectiveness in police work that extends to various law enforcement issues and its effects on the total community. In keeping with the theme of the conference, the events of the week have been designed to facilitate necessary communication and positive police-community relationships.

Immunizations set for children

Since Nevada law requires school children to be up-to-date on their immunizations, now is a good time to check your child's immunization records and get those booster shots.

Children who haven't been completely immunized against childhood disease are at risk of contracting the seven serious, and sometimes deadly diseases — measles, German measles, polio, mumps, diphtheria, whooping cough and tetanus. Clark County Health District officials report

that with the exception of tetanus, these diseases are highly contagious and spread rapidly.

If you haven't checked your child's immunization records lately, compare your records to the schedule provided by the Clark County Health District.

If your child needs a booster, immunizations are available from physicians or Clark County Health District clinics. Public health clinics are open Monday through Friday at three locations: 625 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas; 102 E. Lake Mead Drive, Henderson and 3262 Civic Center Drive, North Las

Vegas. The Las Vegas clinic is open 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.; hours for the Henderson clinic are 8:30 a.m. to noon and 12:30 p.m. to 4 p.m. The North Las Vegas clinic is open 9 a.m. to noon and 12:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Immunization at public

health clinics is provided without charge and no appointment is necessary. Parents should bring immunization records to the clinic. Records must be checked prior to immunization.

Library Offers Two Voter Registration Sites

11 a.m. to 4 p.m. on the upper level of the library. Library volunteer and volunteer deputy registrar Joe Baird will be conducting the registration.

At the West Las Vegas Library (1702 N. "D" St.), Assistant Library Administrator Deborah Richards will register voters

through Saturday, August 2 from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

To qualify to vote, one must be at least 18 years old by election day and a citizen of the United States. Other qualifications include residency in Clark County for 30 days and in one's precinct for 10 days prior to the election.

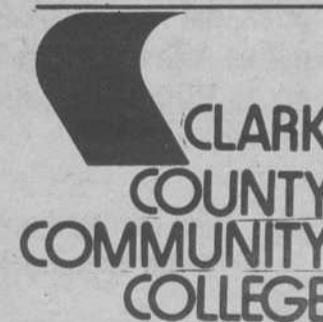
