To Strike-Out Bigotry Motivated Violence

CHICAGO, ILL.--For fifteen dollars you can explore the legal ways to strike back at bigotry-motivated violence from a state and federal level. The National Institute Against Prejudice has issued a report, "Striking Back at Bigotry," that is factual remedial reading on the subject. It is a four chapter report by the Law Firm of Hogan and Hartson, which concludes by cataloging, by states, statutes which specifically address violence inspired by bigotry. The Hon. Birch E. Bayh, Washington, D.C., board chairperson, encourages victims and attorneys to explore city and county laws not included in the report, but which are available. He further stated that the second goal of the report, and the wishes of the entire board, which includes N'York City Police Commissioner Benjamin Ward, is that it will stimulate the development of new laws directed against violence
