Copenhagen, Denmark-- America's senior Black diplomat has declined a Reagan Administration offer to become the first Black U.S. ambassador to South Africa. Currently, the U.S. ambassador to Denmark, Terence Todman appeared to criticize Reagan administration policy toward South Africa. However, administration officials denied that his comments represented a criticism.
