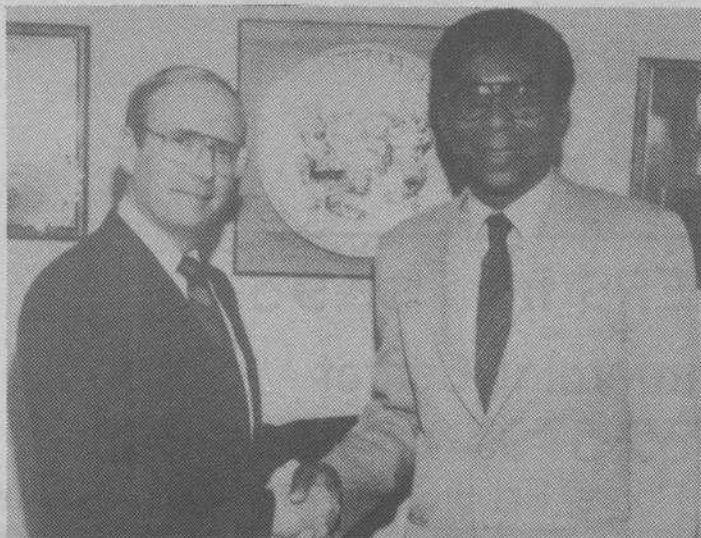

**Committee Formed to Develop
MLK Scenic Loop**

Property owners in the West Las Vegas community are asked to support an idea ventured by Josh Elliott, local accountant and Director of the MLK Institute of Business.

He is asking that the Las Vegas Planning Division approve the idea of changing the name of three major streets in that area. The streets are "D" Street from Bonanza to Owens; Owens Avenue from "D" Street to Highland and Highland Avenue from Owens to Bonanza. He is seeking to

have them changed to Dr. Martin Luther King Scenic Loop.

Elliott says the Las Vegas City Council will meet at City Hall Chambers on Friday, Sept. 3 to make a decision.

The committees handling this project are the Community Revitalization and Beautification Committee; the Credit Building Committee; the Business Design Committee and the Dr. Martin Luther King Scenic Loop Committee.

The committee says it is a part of a five year goal,

through the efforts of the business and property owners to make the loop indeed "scenic".

It is anticipated that the property owners will benefit from a significant number of tourists who would exit off the freeway and travel around the "scenic loop."

The committee is urging property owners to construct various specialty shops, restaurants and other businesses who may capitalize from the new influx of tourist traffic that will drive around the scenic loop.

The plan had been approved earlier by the City of Las Vegas Planning Commission.
