maintaining community awareness. The time and energy donated by the people and small businesses of this community will help to insure the survival of the black culture of our people.

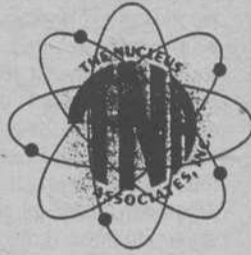
The African Bazaar will be held on August 29 at 6 p.m. inside the Heritage Hall, 950 West Owens. African Art,
