Tucker was known as "The Black Valentino' during the same period when **Budolph Valentino was the** rage of Hollywood. He made more than fifteen films and short pictures under Black film producer, Oscar Michaux, whose films were nothing like the Hollywood versions of Black people. Michaux wrote, produced and directed his own films which dealt with real life

versions of Black life. Tucker also appeared on Broadway in a number of productions, on one occasion with the late Mae West, in her production of "The Constant Sinner" in 1931. The story goes that when the show played Washington, D.C., a scene in which Tucker was to kiss Mae West was ordered cut. Instead. Ms. West closed the show.

Tucker was married four times. Three of his former wives are deceased, and his current wife, Paulina Segura of the Phillipines, survives him. They lived at 1737 N Las Palmas Avenue Hollywood, California 90028. Services took place on

Friday, August 22, in Los Angeles.
