But, most of all, at that Board meeting where formal installation of new officers will be taking place, we also will be pay-

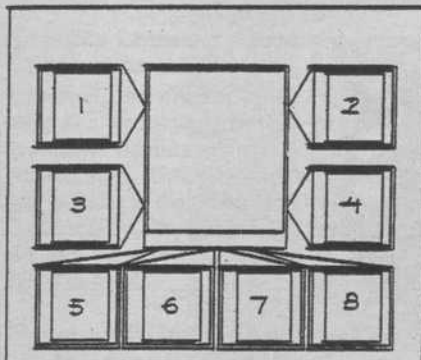
