 Another highlight was the Cultural Extravaganza in which excellent use was made of the magnificent talents within the organization. Information Contact: 312-873-9000.

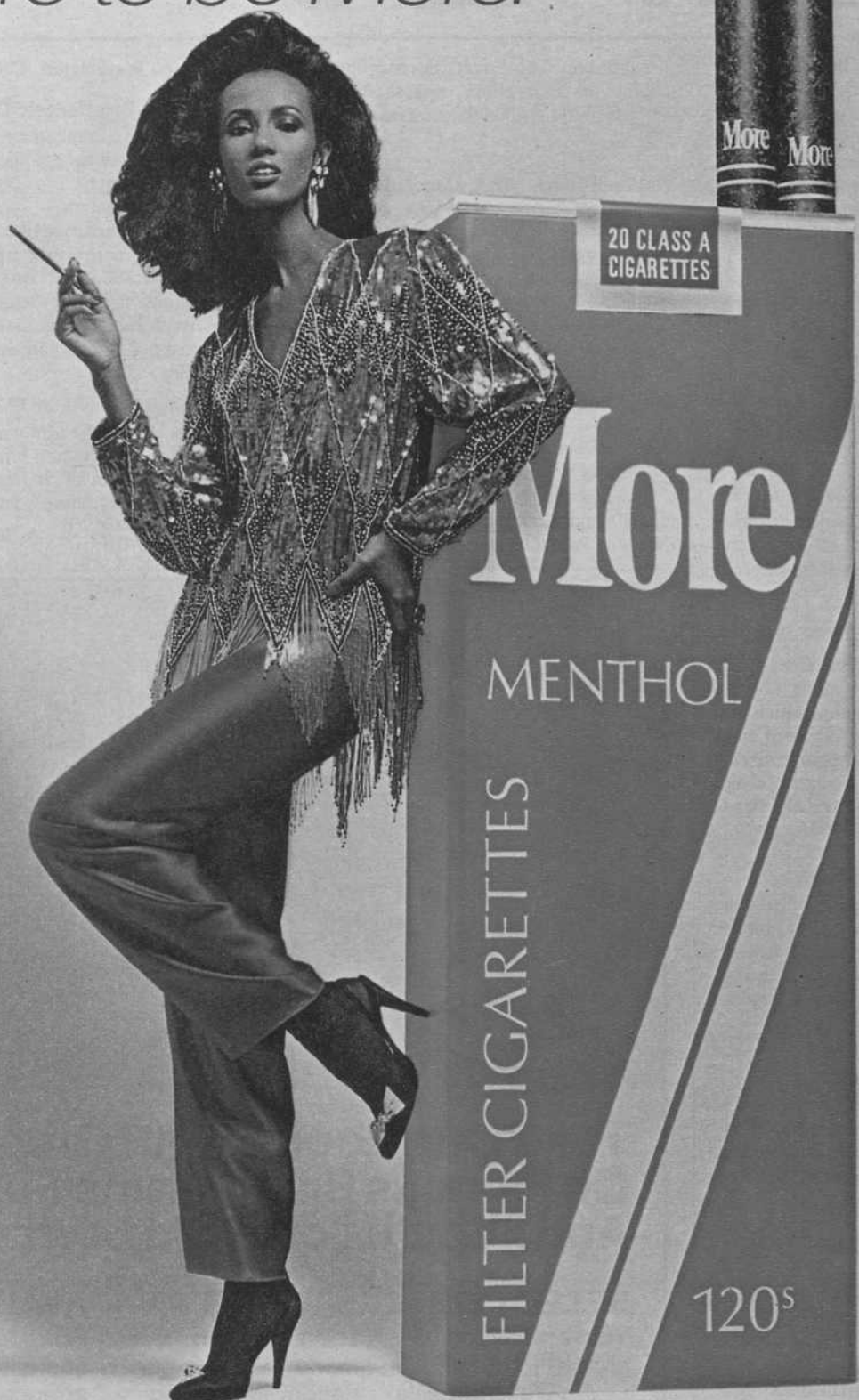
