### -Last Chance To Get Freedom Fund Banquet Tickets-

If you don't cooperate and purchase your ticket in advance, there may be a problem in serving you the night of the banquet. 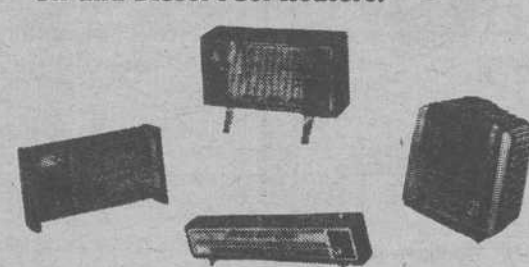
