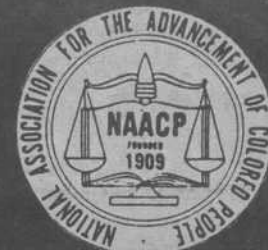

The theme of the banquet is "A Salute to Our Youth". Joining in this salute will be Governor Richard Bryan and Attorney General Brian McKay of Nevada.

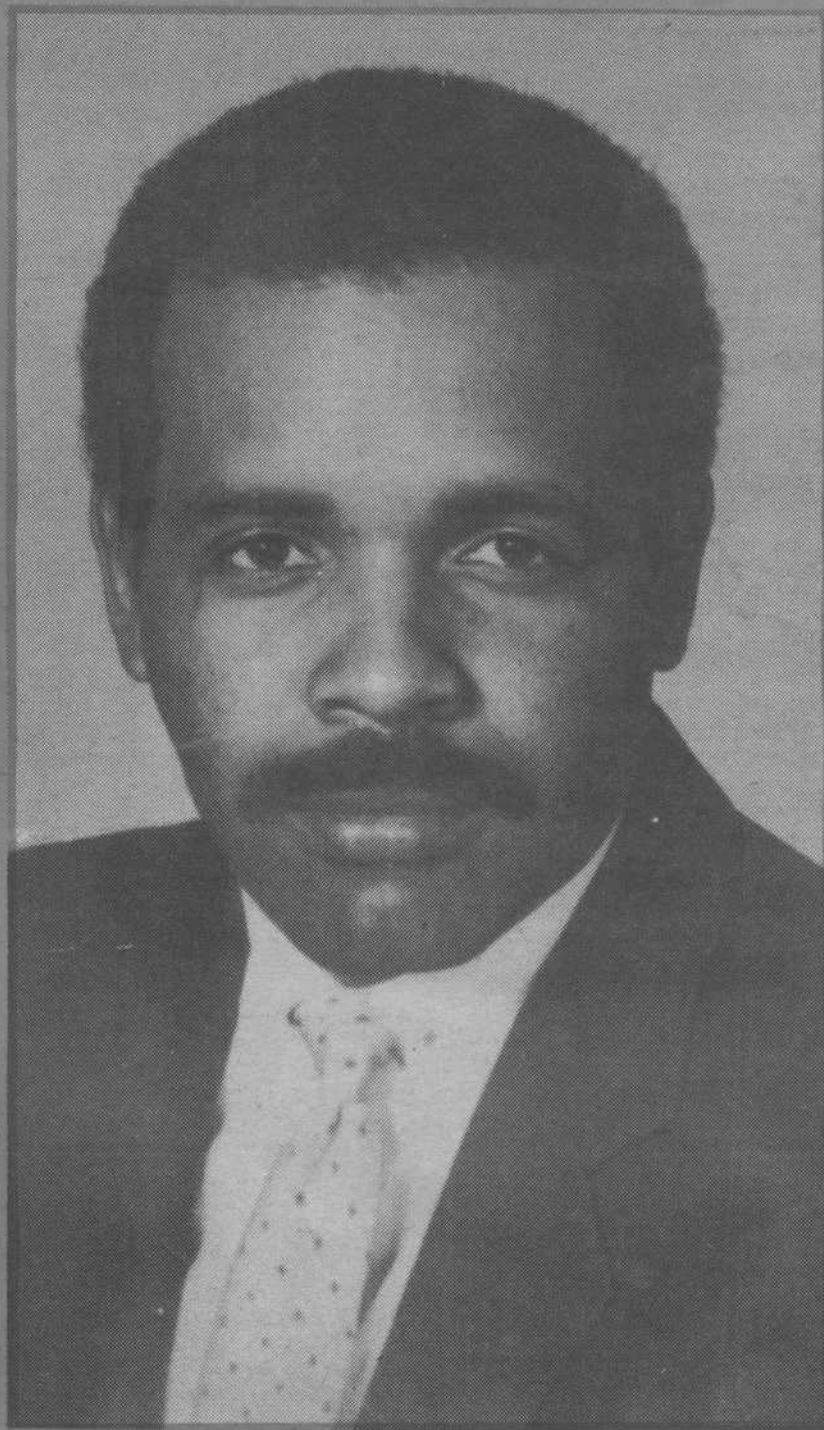
