SOLICITATION OF OFFERS FOR REAL PROPERTY

At the regular scheduled meeting of September 16, 1986, the Board of County Commissioners directed staff to solicit offers of sale to the County from land owners in the vicinity of Clark County Detention Center at 330 South Casino Center Boulevard.

Factors the County will consider:

1. Total cost to the County, including all fees, cannot exceed \$900,000;
2. Ability to connect via tunnel or overhead skyway to the existing jail;
3. Overall comparison of the cost of purchase the land and the estimated cost to utilize it to expand the size of the existing jail;
4. Ability of the County to utilize the vacant property it owns on the southeast corner of Lewis and First; and
5. Security problems, maintenance and other operational costs associated with the offered property.

After reviewing all properties offered, staff will request final offers from those property owners that have property that can be utilized by the County. These final offers will be presented for Board consideration in November. The Board could direct staff to: purchase a particular parcel; negotiate with a particular land owner or more than one land owner; solicit more proposals; or cancel the entire project.

Proposals will be received in the Office of the Director of General Services, Bridger Building, Tenth Floor, 225 Bridger Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada 89155, until the hour of 3 PM, October 22, 1986.

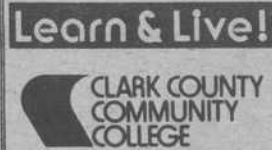
