World-Rated Tillman, Booze Headline Boxing Card Friday, Oct. 17

Olympic gold medalist and world-ranked cruiserweight Henry Tillman of Los Angeles returns to the Sahara Hotel and Casino in a 10-round main event bout against Tyrone Booze of Hartford, Conn., Friday Oct.

The Tillman-Booze main event is one of six bouts on the monthly ESPN card promoted by Bob Arum's Top the 17th. Rank, Inc., in association with the Sahara.

The card starts at 6 p.m. in the Sahara Space Center with doors opening at 5.

Tickets, priced at \$10 for general admission and \$15 for reserved ringside, are on sale 24 hours, seven days a week at the Sahara casino cage plus at the door Friday

Also assembled by Top Rank matchmaker Mel Greb will be undefeated welterweight Joe Belinc of Marysville, Wash.; unbeaten heaveyweight Mike Williams of Conroe, Texas; and Las Vegas junior lightweight Brett Livingston in his pro debut

Tillman, ranked No. 8 both the World Boxing Association and the World Boxing Council and No. 9 by the International Boxing Federation, last fought at the Sahara on Aug. 19 when he stopped Cedric Persons of the Marvelous Marvin Hagler stable in the first round.

On Sept. 24; his most recent outing, Tillman, halted Oscar Holman in the sixth round to improve his record to 21-1 with nine knockouts

inches and with a wicked left jab, won the North American Boxing cruiserweight championship on April 22 with a first-round knockout of Bash Ali, then ranked No. 1 by the WBA, WBC and IBF. But the 26year-old Tillman was upset in the first defense of his NABF title, dropping a 12-round decision to Bert Cooper of the Joe Frazier stable on June 15 in Atlantic City.

Tillman won the gold medal in the heavyweight division at the 1984 Los Angeles Olympics, beating current No. 1-ranked heavyweight Mike Tyson in the box-offs in Las Vegas.

Booze is a superb boxer with a record of 11-5-2 with one knockout. The 27-yearold has been in with the best including former WBA light heaveyweight champion Eddie Mustafa Muhammad, champion current WBA cruiserweight champ Evander Hollyfield and, most recently on Aug. 26 at Lake Tahoe, Cooper in 12-round battle for the NABF title.
