## One Category Sold Out--Tickets Going Fast for Nov. 22 Berbick-Tyson Title Fight

Tickets are selling briskly for the title card Saturday, Nov. 22, at the Las Vegas Hilton between World Boxing Council heavyweight champion Trevor Berbick and undefeated Mike Tyson, and one price category already is sold out.

No tickets remain in the \$75 price category says a Hilton Spokesperson.

Tickets are still available in the \$125, \$250, \$400 and \$600 price categories, although they, too, are selling at a quick pace.

Tickets are on sale seven days a week from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Hilton Special Events Ticket Office, located in the lobby of the hotel.

Tickets may be purchased with all major credit cards, money orders and cash.

The Berbick-Tyson championship card will be held in the 8,500-seat indoor Convention Center. It will be the third heavyweight world championship bout at the Hilton the past seven

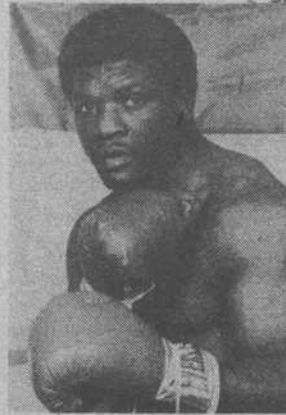
months.

The 12-round championship main event on Nov. 22 features Berbick defending his WBC title against Tyson, the much-talked-about 20-year-old slugging sensation.

Berbick, from Miami Beach, Fla., has a record of 31-4-1 with 23 knockouts and is making his first defense of the WBC championship he won in March by dethroning previously unbeaten Pinklon Thomas.

Tyson, from Catskill, N.Y., has a perfect record of 27-0 with 25 knockouts and is coming off an impressive second-round knockout of former WBC cruiserweight champion Alfonzo Ratliff in September at the Hilton.

Tyson is attempting to make boxing history at the Hilton by becoming the youngest heavyweight world champion ever. Currently, the youngest person to hold that distinction is Floyd

Patterson, who won the world title in 1956, five weeks short of his 22nd birthday. If Tyson wins, he'll be 20 years, five months.

## UNLV basketball gets extensive TV coverage

Five national telecasts highlight a 1986-87 UNLV basketball schedule that will have 22 of the 29 initially scheduled games shown on television.

"When I first came here, we had to go to people to negotiate. Now they come to us," said UNLV Athletic Director Brad Rothermel.

UNLV, which advanced to NCAA Western Regional semifinals en route to a 33-5 record, meets the Yugoslavian National team in an exhibition Nov. 18 at Thomas and Mack. The regular season opens Nov. 21 against Arizona at Thomas and Mack in the opening round of the NIT Classic. The Rebels could get two more televised games in the NIT if they win in the early rounds.
