EFFECTIVENESS

While in Congress, Jim Santini authored eight pieces of legislation that passed through both houses and became law. His legislation affected our state's three most vital industries – tourism, mining and ranching.

RIGHT-TO-WORK

Jim will continue to support the Reagan agenda which has brought our nation and our country back to prosperity. Jim Santini will never support tax increases to fight the deficit.

Harry Reid would not even allow a vote on the Balanced Budget Amendment. And for his liberal voting record while in Congress, Harry has been labeled a "Big Spender" by the National Taxpayers Union every year since he was elected.
