Classic Recipes

His creation, Stuffed French Toast, was introduced as a breakfast item at the Walt Disney World Polynesian Village Resort in 1978. Today, it is the item most sought by collectors of Disney recipes. Stuffed French Toast

2 (Or 4) slices sourdough bread, cut 1-inch thick

l banana

1/3 cup sugar

1 teaspoon cinnamon

egg

4 cup milk


1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
Oil or shortening for frying
Whipped butter, if desired
Maple syrup, if desired

Depending on the size of the slices of bread, cut a 2-inch pocket in one side of each bread slice. Cut bananas in half crosswise, then split each piece lengthwise. Remove peel and stuff 2 pieces in each pocket of bread, again depending on size. If slices are small, use 4 and stuff 1 piece of banana in each pocket. Set aside.

Mix sugar and cinnamon. Set aside.

Mix egg, milk and vanilla until well blended.

Heat about 4 inches of oil in a pan to 350°F.
